Linda Headrick, MD, MS is a Helen Mae Spiese Distinguished Faculty Scholar, Senior Associate Dean for Education and Faculty Development, and Professor of Medicine at the School of Medicine, University of Missouri-Columbia. Dr. Headrick's primary research interest is in the application of continuous quality improvement to health professions education. She is a member of the Steering Committee for IHI's Health Professions Education Collaborative and Editor-in-Chief of the Health Improvement Skills Center (HISC). HISC includes six Web-based, case-based interactive learning modules on the core principles and methods of improvement (www.improvementskills.org).

At the University of Missouri-Columbia, Dr. Headrick has responsibility for the undergraduate, graduate and continuing medical education programs of the School of Medicine and for faculty development needs in education and scholarly development. She also is a program director in the University of Missouri Center for Healthcare Quality, where she continues work in research and innovation for the improvement of health care and health professions education.
